### **After School Site Director**

Site Directors are responsible for the management of their assigned site, including staff, school-age children and activities. Supervise site record keeping including attendance, food program count, enrollment forms, conferences with parents, and any communication with the school office.

### **After School Youth Group Leaders**

Group Leaders are responsible for supervising school-age children in an appropriate manner that contributes to their growth and development. Applicant must have high school diploma or meet section 3300A of DPRS Minimum Standards.

### **CDL Bus Driver**

Responsible for safely transporting participants enrolled in our After School programs to and from various locations. Individual must be age 25 or older, have a high school diploma or GED and a Commercial Driver's License with a good driving record.

### **Custodian**

The Custodian maintains overall cleanliness of facility in compliance with housekeeping checklist. Responsibilities will include attending to men or women's and family locker rooms. Applicant must have high school diploma or GED.

### **Lifeguards**

Maintain a safe and neat pool environment for all aquatics participants. Following and enforcing all pool/facility rules and regulations. Be able to lead others and communicate effectively with people of all ages, individually or in groups. Applicant must have a current Lifeguard certification and CPR/First Aid/AED certifications.

### **Membership Representative**

The Membership Representative delivers excellent service to all members, guests, and program participants. Excellent knowledge of computers and office software is required as well as cash handling experience. Strong interpersonal and human relations skills are critical. Weekend availability is required. Applicant must possess a high school diploma or GED. Ability to speak Spanish is a plus.

### **Personal Trainer**

The Personal Trainer welcomes, connects, and supports clients in achieving their healthy living goals. Works with the client to develop and implement a plan focusing on strength and wellness to result in improving the quality of life. Must maintain Personal Training Instructor certification. Applicant must have high school diploma or GED.

### **Sports Leader**

The Sports Leader provides direction in all assigned sports classes and activities while ensuring a safe and healthy environment. Provides a quality experience for children and parents. Knowledge and experience in organized youth sports preferred. Weekend availability is required.

### **Sports Official Youth & Adult**

The Sports Official officiates assigned games and assists with the operations of assigned leagues and programs; and is responsible for courteous relations with all members, program participants and visitors. Weekend availability is required.

### **Wellness Center Attendant**

The Wellness Center Attendant creates a safe environment while welcoming, connecting and supporting members in achieving their wellness goals. Assist participants with cardio or weight equipment. Actively participates in maintaining equipment sanitation standards. Applicant must have high school diploma or GED.

All positions must complete CPR/ First Aid certification within 30 days of hire.  
Employment is contingent upon a successful completion of a criminal background check.
